

NC Oral Presentation Plan

- Voluntary this year (2010). Score will not count in contest
- Will be required part of competition for 2011
- Will be part of rotation on Friday (6th Station, 40 minutes each)
- Length of presentations will be 10 – 12 minutes (12 - 15 minutes for 2011)
- Station timing 2010
 - 5 minutes travel
 - 5 minutes set up
 - 12 minute presentation
 - 5 minutes for questions
 - 5 minutes for judging
 - 5 minutes for feedback
- Score for presentation will count as 1/6 of total score(2011)
 - A maximum of 100 points
- Recognize top three teams – top team will receive medallions (as a top station team)
- Judges training 12:30 – 1:30 on Friday check in at 12:00 (lunch will be provided)
- Start High School Stations at 2:30 and will conclude at 6:30
- There will be 10 presentation stations (subject to change)
 - Depending on number registering this year
 - Three Judges
 - One Station Monitor Chief
- Station Equipment x 10
 - Tent
 - One table
 - Four chairs
 - One easel
 - Stopwatch
 - Time card sets
 - Score sheets
 - Pencils
 - Snacks
 - Water
- Offer Advisor Training at Area Envirothons
- Saturday Teacher Workshop at State competitions on Oral Presentations
- Will develop score sheets (using Canon's)
- Training materials and example videos will be put on website by early March
- The high school oral presentation component problem will be emailed to all team advisors and put on website on April 8th
- Acceptable presentation visual aids
 - 24 x 30 Maximum poster board size, can use both sides – no more than 2 sheets
 - Hand drawn or written, no computer generated or pre-printed materials

- No additional props
- 3" x 5" Standard note cards are allowed, no maximum number
- No audio, visual or electronic equipment at all
- Materials will be turned in at time of Registration, kept until time of presentation,
 - Team will be identified by number, put number on nametags
- We are following the general guidelines of the Canon Envirothon Competition

More volunteers for Judges, timer/chiefs, scorers, runners (50 needed for full competition)
