

# Envirothon Registration

Registration of an Envirothon team is easy.

Step 1: Contact your local Soil & Water Conservation Office and ask them to register your team (see local District Contacts).

Step 2: The local District should register your team or teams and provide you with resources to study and additional resources to get started. They should also be able to supply you with contacts, who may be able to come to your class and give a presentation on one or more of the subject areas (soils/land use, aquatic ecology, wildlife, forestry and current environmental issues). You may want to take your class/teams on field trips to look at wetlands, visit museums, go to a state park, a Small Educational State Forest, to look at some water quality issues, etc.

Step 3: Get your team organized and on a study plan, be it self- study or teacher presentations and outside presentations along with self-study.

Step4: Ask your local District to help you run a self mock Envirothon for your teams to practice.

Step 5: Participate in your local or Area Envirothon.

Step 6: If the local District does not want to register you, contact your local Area contact person (see Area Envirothon Information). Contact them and they can get you registered.
